All teachers, staff, and students (including planning assistants) returning to Taiwan from China, Macau, Hong Kong, or Kinmen, Penghu, and Lienchiang counties (including layovers) after January 20th, 2020, as well as countries the CDC deemed as 1st, 2nd, or 3rd level epidemic threat locations since February 25th, should, on their own initiative, inform their supervisor or special advisor and fill out the online form entitled "Documentation for NTNU Students/Faculty/Staff Arriving from China/Hong Kong/Macau."

1. All students/faculty/staff and guests, please fill out the "NTNU COVID-19 Survey."
2. The survey data will be posted on the "NTNU Coronavirus" webpage. /staff and guests, please fill out the "NTNU COVID-19 Survey."

The relevant supervisor or department director/special advisor will continue to follow-up with the faculty/staff/student's health condition, according with the National Health Command Center's "Measures for Following-Up on Persons at Risk of Infection," and comply with relevant regulations.
